The Pinery wastewater treatment facility is a BNR water reclamation facility with capacity to treat 2.0 MGD, followed by tertiary water treatment filters for enhanced chemical phosphorous removal. Our Operators perform skilled work in the operation, maintenance and basic laboratory testing of water reclamation systems, including maximum efficiency of facility equipment utilizing preventative, predictive and emergency maintenance and taking great pride in facility cleanliness and appearance.

General qualifications for this job are detailed below. A successful candidate would have, at a minimum the following Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Thorough, detail oriented and well organized.
- Mechanical aptitude and knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions pertaining to all phases of operation and maintenance in a wastewater treatment plant utilizing mechanical, chemical and electrical equipment.
- Ability to observe, monitor and correct issues, as needed, in compliance with operating procedures and/or safety standards.
- State of Colorado Wastewater D certification must be obtained within one year after date of hire.
- Obtain State of Colorado Wastewater C certification within three years after date of hire.
- Valid Colorado driver's license with an acceptable MVR.
- Lives within 30 minutes of the WWTP and is available to participate in an on-call rotation.

Ideal candidates will:

- Be capable of multi-tasking, being resourceful in the field, and maintaining a positive attitude;
- Have excellent interpersonal and communication skills;
- Utilize a "safety" mindset when working;
- Have a strong sense of collaboration and teamwork, yet thrive when working independently;
- Demonstrate accuracy and thoroughness in work products;
- Have previous water/wastewater utility experience;
- Be willing to admit what they do not know, and have the desire to learn;

- Have experience using and be well versed in Microsoft Office software products; and
- Have a High School diploma or G.E.D.

Must satisfactorily pass a criminal background check and drug test prior to commencement of employment. Compensation is dependent upon qualifications; starting pay is targeted between \$19.00 to \$27.00 per hour.
