## A YEAR IN REVIEW

For most of us the year is spent rushing around taking care of the things that need the most attention on any given day. This year is no different and I wanted to take some time to review some of the things the Board of Directors and the staff at the District have been working on.

Here are some of the highlights of performance in 2019 from our great staff at the Pinery Water and Wastewater District:

- Pumped, treated and delivered close to 1.05 *BILLION* gallons of water safely.
- Treated approximately 260 million gallons of wastewater and safely returned it to Cherry Creek.
- Installed Manual Transfer Switches at various water pumping stations to provide power from generators in times of power outages to ensure continued water service.
- Once again staff stayed under budget for 2019 so that residential and commercial customers will see no increase to rates in 2020. In 2020, the District will update its Rates and Fees study and the community is invited to take part in those discussions that will take place at several of the regular Board meetings throughout the year.
- Construction to replace three sections of the most impacted water pipelines in the District to ensure reliability and reduce interruptions in service and costly emergency repairs. Thank you to all those impacted by the construction for your patience and understanding
- Completed satellite imaging of the District's entire potable pipeline network to identify potential subsurface leaks.
- Negotiated the sale of excess District infrastructure to surrounding water providers which then allowed the District to pay off loans and resolve millions of dollars of debt early.

All these efforts together help support the vision of the District to provide **Quality Water for LIFE** in our community. The Board and staff here at the District would like to wish you happy holidays!


