From your board of directors

As of May, the number of water connections serviced by the Pinery Water District reached 4,828. Buildout is approximately 5,700 homes, at which time home construction will come to a screeching halt. Last year 288 homes were built while the number this year will reach and possibly surpass the projected number of 120. Since economic conditions determine new home construction, it's difficult to predict when buildout will be reached.

Since the construction of new homes is reaching buildout, will we have enough water to service them? Our resources include a major renewable supply from Cherry Creek (which we are fortunate to own water rights to), the purchase of 500-acre feet of Denver water via the WISE program, the Franktown Walker Pit that will accumulate and store up to 650-acre feet of excess water supplies for use when we need it most, and the availability of Deep non-renewable wells 2,000 feet below that we can tap into when needed.


By year-end, we project installation of the Eye-On-Water device to each meter pit in the District, giving each resident the ability to monitor water usage on an hourly, daily, monthly, and yearly basis. As of May, 655 installations have been completed but only 326 residents have activated their accounts. The District's goal is to have 100% of the residents activated on the Eye-On-Water app/website. Once installed, should you need help activating, please call the District office at 303-841-2797. With these resources and your participation in monitoring your water use, the answer to the question above is an emphatic Yes.

The graph to the right shows the District's financial forecast. Considering the district's robust cash position, your Board recently approved paying off a significant portion of debt, saving the district approximately \$100,000.00 in interest charges this year alone. This is good news for you as debt reduction has the potential to lower or minimize increases to your water bill. By the end of 2021, the projected cash position will be about \$30 million although how we spend it is restricted in many instances by board and state designations as well as appropriation regulations.
