From your Board of Directors

In 2014 the Pinery Water board entered into an agreement to purchase excess water from Denver Water and Aurora Water. The Pinery was one of ten water districts participating in what is called the WISE project.

The original WISE contract calls for each partner to buy a volume of water at an agreed price and pay their portion of the capital costs to move the water from the South Platte River to their respective districts. The total water available is 10,000-acre feet annually. After much deliberation the Pinery Water Board agreed to buy an average of 500-acre feet each year and pay the delivery cost. At that time, the thinking was that this alternate supply would take the pressure off our deep wells.

The pipelines were built with various pumps and storage tanks to move water from the South Platte River to a distribution pipe along E470 called the Western Pipeline. The members were then required to move the water from the Western pipeline to each member's individual water system. Pinery Water, along with other partners including Parker Water and Castle Rock Water, then built a pipeline to the Parker area. Pinery Water then formed an agreement with Parker Water to use their existing water pipelines to move the water to us. Connections were installed, Parker Water pipelines to Pinery Water pipelines on the north end of our system and Pinery Water lines to Castle Rock Water lines on the south end of our system. These agreements helped reduce the overall delivery cost and provide connections for future water exchanges if needed.

When we entered the WISE agreement the raw water reservoir in Franktown was still a dream. That dream became reality in early 2025 with the completion of the Walker Reservoir. Now we no longer need the WISE water and ongoing maintenance costs of that system. Heather Beasley, Pinery Water and Wastewater District Manager, just completed negotiations for the sale of our WISE interests to Castle Rock Water and Parker Water Districts, 50% to each. The total price was just over four million dollars, which covered our capital, operational reserves and annual dues costs for the WISE project. This money will now be used to help expand the Walker Reservoir.

INAWATER CONSERVATION RESOURCES

The District currently offers two programs to permanently reduce your outdoor water use. The first is the Turf Replacement Rebate Program, which is a great opportunity to conserve water while enhancing the beauty of your landscape. Residential customers may qualify for a rebate of \$5 per square foot—up to \$2,000 total—by removing water-intensive grass and replacing it with Colorado-friendly, low-water landscaping. The second program, called *Slow the Flow*, provides free sprinkler system audits through Resource Central. Gain knowledge about your system, get a customized watering schedule, and learn ways to improve efficiency and reduce water waste.
